SCA is a community Christian school assisting families by providing academic excellence while instilling biblical principles in its students' lives so they might reach and impact the next generation with a life "all in" for Jesus.

Vision of Salem Christian Academy

SCA stands as a lighthouse of Kingdom Education for those seeking a Christ-centered place of excellence and a loving and caring environment where students can launch into adult life equipped with the character and skills to navigate successfully for God's service.

Statement of Doctrinal Beliefs

- 1. **The Scriptures:** We believe that the entire Bible is verbally inspired by God and is inerrant in the original writings. Through the providence of God, the Word of God has been protected and preserved, and is the only infallible and authoritative rule of faith and practice (2 Tim. 3:16-17; 2 Pet. 1:20-21).
- 2. **God:** We believe that there is only one true, living, sovereign, holy, and eternally existent God. He exists in three co-equal persons, Father, Son, and Holy Ghost, each being a distinct person and with a distinct function, but all of one essence and all possessing the same nature, perfections, and attributes. The triune God is the creator and sustainer of all things, the source of all truth, and is worthy of worship, confidence, and obedience (Deut. 6:4-5; Gen. 1:31).
- 3. Jesus Christ: We believe that Jesus Christ is God. He was conceived by the Holy Spirit, born of a virgin, lived a sinless life, performed many miracles, shed His blood on the cross to pay the debt of our sins, was buried, bodily resurrected, ascended to the right hand of the Father, and will return literally, visibly, and personally, in glory and power (Jn. 1:1-3; 14; Matthew 1:18-25; Phil. 2:5-9; Col. 1:15; I Cor. 15:1-8; Acts 1:11).
- 4. **Holy Spirit:** We believe that the Holy Spirit of God is co-equal and co-existent with the Father and the Son. He convicts of sin, the chief agent of regeneration and

sanctification. The Holy Spirit lives within every believer and empowers every believer to live a godly life (Jn. 14:16-19; 16:7-15; I Cor. 6:19-20; Rom. 8:9,11; Titus 3:5).

- 5. **Mankind:** We believe that in the beginning God created mankind in His image and is not in any sense the product of evolution. We believe in the literal seven days of Creation as written in God's Word. Mankind was originally created with the ability to live perfectly for God's glory (Gen. 1:1-27,31).
- 6. **Sin:** We believe that Adam, the first man, sinned by disobedience. This act resulted in the fall of mankind, therefore, all people have sinned and lost their ability to live for the glory of God. Every person's sin incurs both physical and spiritual death until there is forgiveness and salvation by the grace of God (Gen. 3:1-24; Rom. 3:10-23; 5:12-21; 6:23).
- 7. **Salvation:** We believe the salvation of lost and sinful people is a free gift of God's grace apart from human works, based solely upon Christ's vicarious and atoning death, affected by the regenerating work of the Holy Spirit, and received only through faith in the person and finished work of Jesus Christ on the cross and His resurrection from death (Eph. 2:8-10; 2 Cor. 5:21).

Statement on Marriage, Gender, and Sexuality

We believe that God wonderfully and immutably creates each person as male or female. These two distinct, complementary genders together reflect the image and nature of God. (Gen 1:26-27). We believe that the term "marriage" has only one meaning: the uniting of one man and one woman in a single, exclusive union, as delineated in Scripture. (Gen 2:18-25.) We believe that God intends sexual intimacy to occur only between a man and a woman who are married to each other. (1 Cor. 6:18; 7:2-5; Heb. 13:4.) We believe that God has commanded that no intimate sexual activity be engaged in outside of a marriage between a man and a woman. We believe that any form of sexual immorality (including adultery, fornication, homosexual behavior, transgender or bisexual conduct, bestiality, incest, and use of pornography) is sinful and offensive to God. (Matt 15:18-20; 1 Cor. 6:9-10). We believe that in order to preserve the function and integrity of Salem Christian Academy, as a ministry within Salem Baptist Church, and to provide a biblical role model to the Salem Christian Academy families and community, it is imperative that all persons employed by Salem Christian Academy in any capacity, or who serve as volunteers, agree to and abide by this Statement on Marriage, Gender, and Sexuality. (Matt 5:16; Phil 2:14-16; 1 Thess. 5:22). We believe that every person must be afforded compassion, love, kindness, respect, and dignity. (Mark 12:28-31; Luke 6:31.)
